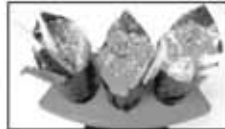

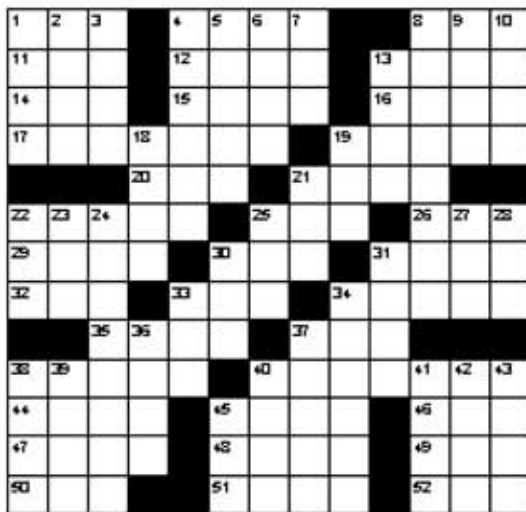

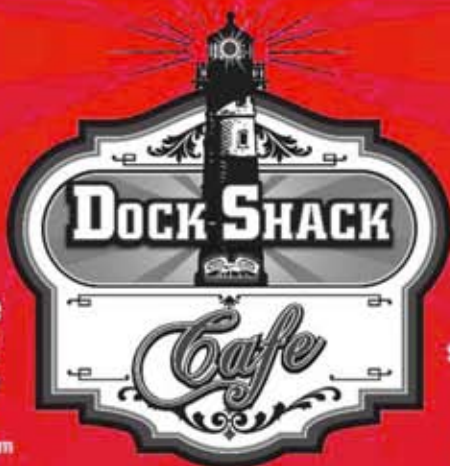

Trevor has Alternating Hemiplegia of Childhood, a progressive neurological disorder. There are only 1,000 kids world wide with this disease. He has 25-30 hemiplegic attacks per month. These attacks can cause paralysis on both sides of the body, and can affect speech, swallowing and breathing This disease will progress until the seizures can't be stopped. Although Trevor has access to Medicaid, his parents still have many expenses associated with his health, daily care and flights to and from hospitals. 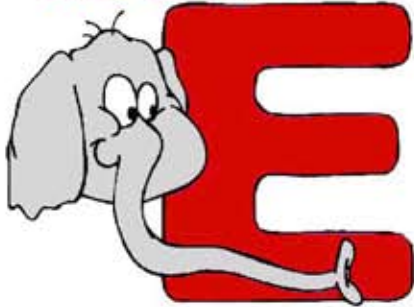

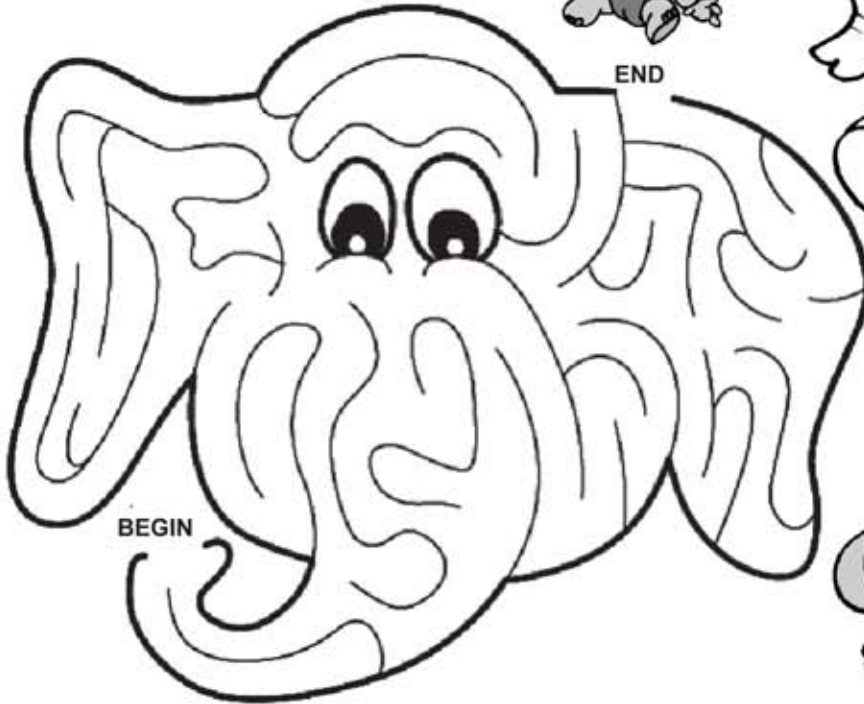
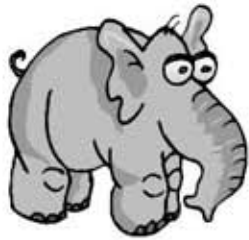
