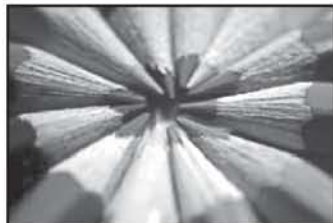

Free Spring Migration Bird Walks to be held at Sitka National Historical Park. If you are interested in observing and learning about the migrant and resident bird species of Sitka National Historical Park, join a ranger for free guided bird walks Saturday mornings during the month of May. Spring Migration Bird Walks will be held on Saturday, May 24th and 31st from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. These free bird walks are open to beginner and experienced bird watchers and will offer participants the chance to identify and learn about the abundant bird species that depend on the park's coastal and rain forest ecosystems.
