

They are children's size and have white hide soles crimped at the toe and heel with a single piece of smoked moose hide uppers sewn with a welted seam up the back and decorated with seed beads. The slippers were not collected by Sheldon Jackson but by Moravian missionaries, one of several denominations Jackson influenced to come to Alaska in the late 19th century. The September Artifact will be exhibited until Sept 30. General admission is \$7, \$6 for seniors, and free for those 18 and under or members of either the Friends of the Sheldon Jackson Museum or Friends of the Alaska State
