



Sitka National Historical Park is now in our summer hours of operation. This year, the Visitor Center & the Russian Bishop House will have the same hours of operation - open daily from 8am to 4:30pm. At the Visitor Center, Ranger-led interpretive programs will be held daily, with topics focusing on the stories and legends of the totem poles,

the Battle of 1804, sea otter ecology and other aspects of the park's natural and cultural history. The park's 12-minute film will be played on request. Master artisans will be demonstrating in the art studios on days when cruise ships are in town. The Russian Bishop's House Ranger-led tours of the upstairs residence will be offered every 30 minutes,

on the hour & half hour, with the first program beginning at 8:30 a.m. and the last tour beginning at 4:00 p.m. The 1st floor hosts a selfguided museum & video that are available anytime during open hours.
