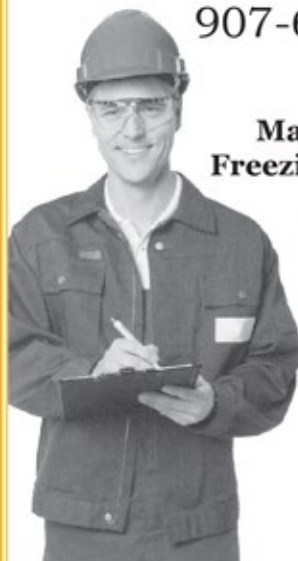

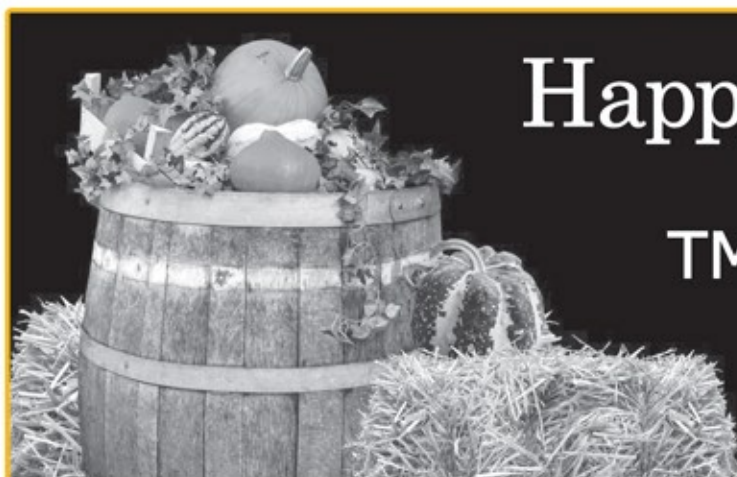

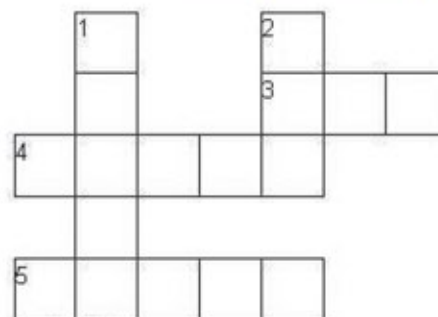

Many objects are visible in the night sky when it's not cloudy! We can see stars, constellations of stars, planets, the moon, the Aurora (Northern Lights) and sometimes even the International Space Station (ISS)!

Hints for spotting the ISS:

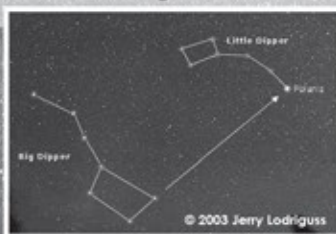
The space station looks like a fast-moving plane in the sky, but it appears as a steady – not blinking – white pinpoint of light. Usually it will be the brightest object in the night sky (except for the moon). This is what it looks like up close.

Stars & Other Things We See in the Night Sky

A constellation is group of stars like a dot-to-dot puzzle. If you join the dots—stars, that is—and use your imagination, the picture would look like an object, animal, or person. For example, the Big Dipper (Ursa Major) is a group of stars that resembles a soup ladle. In Alaska the Big Dipper is visible year round.



The Aurora is a natural electric phenomenon that creates bright, colorful light displays in the sky. In the northern hemisphere, they are known as Aurora Borealis. In the southern hemisphere they are called Aurora Australis.

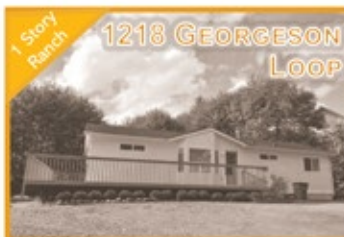

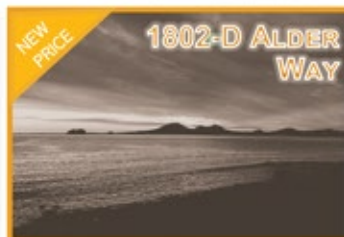
