Ed. Note - For Kids and Other People - What Should I do with the stones? (not a guide to watching old Donna Reed episodes on T.V.)


- You should spit out the stone (not swallow it that is another whole story).
- But you don't have to throw it away in the garbage.
- You can throw it away outdoors, on soil or in a garden, for instance.
- It will eventually biodegrade (go back to the earth) although it will take a long time, depending on the size of the stone.
- You could put it in a compost pile, where it can provide texture and aeration until it does biodegrade.
- For people who live in the right kind of climate, you can even take the actual seed or kernel inside the stone, plant it in soil and sprout it to make a seedling which can grow into a fruit tree - there are about 5 gazillion articles on the internet about how to do this, BUT, as with all things on the internet, you have to pick and choose the best information (kind of like sifting compost, huh?)
- Look up the USDA Map of Plant Hardiness Zones in Alaska. Cherries may grow best in hardiness zones of 4 through 9; peaches, in zones 5 through 9.

Stone fruits are fleshy fruits with a hard "stone" inside. The "stone" is often mistaken for the "seed" but that's not *quite* right - the seed is *inside* the stone! The stone can also be called a "pit." Peaches, nectarines, plums, lychees, mangoes, apricots & cherries are all examples of stone fruits.


