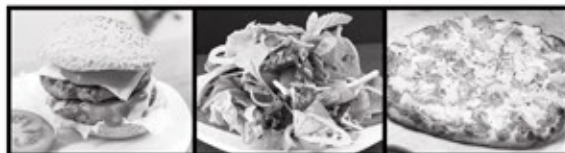

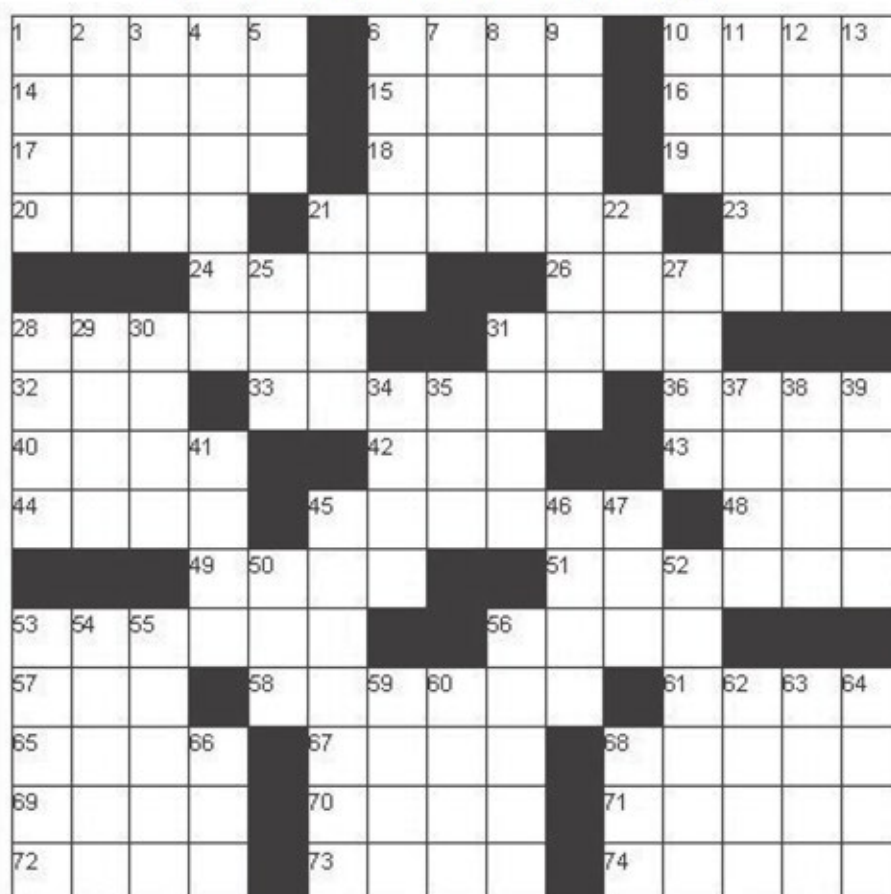

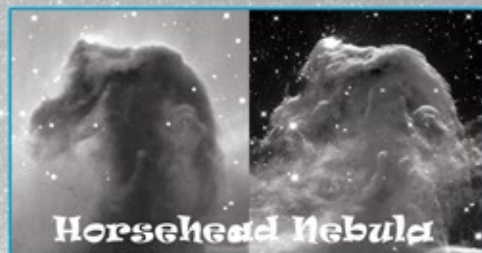

Horsehead Nebula

Astronomers are scientists who study the universe and the objects within, including planets, stars, galaxies, asteroids, black holes, and other celestial bodies. They use radio and optical telescopes on earth, as well as space-based telescopes and other tools to make observations and collect data.

Williamina Paton Stevens Fleming

Fleming (1857 – 1911) was a Scottish astronomer. She helped develop a system for classifying stars according to the amount of hydrogen they contain & cataloged thousands of stars. A female colleague refined the system using stars' surface temperature. Fleming is also known for her discovery of the Horsehead Nebula in 1888.



Vera Rubin

Rubin (1928 – 2016) was an American astronomer whose parents came from Eastern Europe. She began watching stars as a 10-year old. Rubin & her father built a telescope when she was in her teens. During her long career, Rubin was known for her work on the motion of galaxies. She discovered a difference between the predicted & the observed motion of galaxies. This phenomenon is known as the galaxy rotation problem.
