#### Vera Rubin

Rubin (1928 - 2016) was an American astronomer whose parents came from Eastern Europe. She began watching stars as a 10-year old. Rubin & her father built a telescope when she was in her teens. During her long career, Rubin was known for her work on the motion of galaxies. She discovered a difference between the predicted & the observed motion of galaxies. This phenomenon is known as the galaxy rotation problem.


