
Ferry Ending Service to Prince Rupert As of Oct. 1, 2019, the Alaska Marine Highway System is ending service to Prince Rupert, BC. AMHS is unable to

meet requirements for U.S. Customs in Prince Rupert. U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is requiring AMHS to secure a Canadian law enforcement presence to protect CBP's personnel in Prince Rupert while inspection tasks are performed. All avenues for local law enforcement were pursued, but AMHS was not able to secure the staff necessary to fulfill this requirement. The new requirement specifies a Canadian law enforcement presence

Sept. 30. Over the summer, AMHS worked with the City of Prince Rupert and the RCMP to meet this requirement, but neither of these entities have staff available to perform the duties necessary to comply with the new requirement.






