SEARHC Plan & Web Portal for COVID-19 In an effort to consolidate information on the novel coronavirus and increase patient access to the latest information, SEARHC launched the web page covid19.searhc.org SEARHC facilities have taken steps to eliminate the threat of COVID-19 contact to patients and long-term care residents. All facilities have limited points of entry, with signage posted to clearly direct patients and visitors to designated entrances. Visiting hours are limited to 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. until further notice, with all visitors of long-term care locations required to participate in a brief health screening. "Our clinics and hospitals remain open to meet the healthcare needs of all our patients. We encourage patients to continue to access care at our facilities," said Bruhl. "Our efforts to screen patients before they enter ensures that our facilities remain a safe location to receive care." Supplies for the Alaska State COVID-19 test are being distributed to all SEARHC clinical locations, with results available within 48-72 hours. State tests will be supplemented with test kits from LabCorp in the coming days to meet potential demands. For testing, patients must be symptomatic, displaying a fever and cough, or shortness of breath, in addition to meeting exposure risk criteria. These criteria now include travel to areas in the U.S. with significant outbreak occurrence, such as Wash., Calif., or N.Y., as well as

recent travel to China, Italy, Hong Kong, South Korea, Japan, and Iran, or any exposure to a confirmed case. Avoiding close contact with ill persons remains the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) preferred action to prevent the contracting of any virus, followed closely by avoiding touching one's eyes, nose and mouth. The CDC also recommends the continued practice of everyday preventive methods to deter potential contraction of COVID-19, including Washing your hands thoroughly and often, Covering of coughs and sneezes, Cleaning and disinfecting surfaces and objects, and Getting a flu shot. SEARHC continues to recommend that patients with chronic illnesses such as diabetes, cancer, or immune compromise

should contact their doctor immediately if they become ill, while healthy people should stay home if they become sick. SEARHC also launched the web page covid19.searhc.org. For health questions or concerns outside of normal clinic hours, patients can contact the 24/7 Nurse Advice Line at 1(800) 613-0560 to be triaged by a registered nurse. 4905e6cf7eb8e75a

SEARHC Testing SitesTo expedite the COVID19 testing process &

eliminate unnecessary contamination of primary care clinics, SEARHC opened alternative testing sites in five communities. Patients in Juneau, Sitka, Wrangell, Haines, and Klawock can now receive a referral for drive-by testing, which allows patients to remain in their vehicle while being seen by a SEARHC clinician. Appointments may be required for testing. For information on screening in your community, please call: Sitka (907) 966-8799; Juneau (907) 463-4040; Wrangell (907) 874-4700; Klawock (907) 755-4800; Haines (907) 766-6300. Each testing site is manned by a SEARHC clinician in approved personal protection equipment (including mask, goggles, gloves, and gown). If the patient meets the CDCapproved guidelines,

they will be scheduled for a drive-by appt. during regular business hours. Patients will be tested for influenza, and if negative for influenza, be administered a COVID-19 test. CDC Guidelines state that patients must be exhibiting symptoms of COVID 19 (fever and cough, or shortness of breath) and meet the current clinical criteria, including close contact with a confirmed case: travel outside of Alaska within 14 days; or determined to be a high-risk patient. Grab-and-Go Breakfast

& Lunch for Kids The Sitka School District has received a waiver from the State to allow school meal service during the emergency school closure. Beginning Monday, March 23 - the district is planning to distribute Grab-and-Go BREAKFAST and LUNCH once a day at community locations, like Sitka High School. Meals will be FREE to all children 18 and under - regardless of school enrollment - if at least one child in the household attends SSD. SSD students over age 18 are also eligible. All families with an economic need are encouraged to participate. Voting

The Alaska Democratic Party will hold its party-run presidential primary exclusively by mail and is moving back the deadlines for returning and tabulating ballots. The primary is now open only to registered Democrats.

The party announced it is canceling in-person voting sites planned for April 4 due to concerns with the coronavirus. But it is extending the deadline to return ballots by mail. Originally, ballots were to

be postmarked by March 24. They must be received in Anchorage no later than April 10 to be counted.

Results are expected no later than just before midnight on April 11.

They want to continue to allow for maximum participation in this historic primary while respecting the health and safety of our voters and volunteers. Ballots also will be made available to download, the party said. 
