



The Soupster haunted the docks the last few April days, studying skiffs. With no prior symptoms to warn him, the boat bug had bitten him squarely and he mightily suffered its effects.

Extended CBS at its meeting on April 14 passed an ordinance extending the real property tax assessment APPEAL DATE from April 15, 2020 to June 15, 2020. The ordinance states "the COVID-19 pandemic has caused great personal hardships and inconveniences that have made it extremely difficult for many persons owning real property in Sitka to meet the deadline for filing an appeal." Utility Payment Policy - To assist our citizens in this difficult time. CBS has these temporary policies. The Municipality is suspending all disconnections for non-payment of utility charges (related to COVID-19 impacts) until further notice. Alaskans Own 2020 - the community-supported fishery program run by the Alaska Longline

Fishermen's Association (ALFA), is receiving subscription orders for the 2020 season. Prices: Four-Month Feed-A-Few share (5 lbs./month, May-August), \$375 paid in full or \$99 monthly payment; Six-Month Feed-A-Few share (5 lbs./ month, May-October), \$565 paid in full or \$99 monthly payment. Subscriptions include a mix of premium locally hook-and-line caught black cod (sablefish), halibut, king salmon, coho salmon, ling cod and rockfish, depending on the commercial fishing season and prices. Alaskans Own is working with SPC for people to donate to cover a box of individually quickfrozen fillets delivered to the doors of Sitka's families in need. Boxes are \$30 and weigh approx. 10 lbs. To learn more about Alaskans Own, the donation program and how their CSF works.





PSAs from City RE: Covid-19

Hunker Down Resolution
Extended through May
12 - The Assembly of the
City and Borough of Sitka

adopted a resolution at

their April 14, 2020 meeting extending the order for people in the City and Borough of Sitka to hunker down related to COVID-19.

Thank you for doing your part, Sitka, in helping to prevent and slow the spread of COVID-19. At the time of this post, we have no known cases of COVID-19 in Sitka. We know staying home hasn't been easy but this, in addition to washing your hands often, and maintaining a six-foot physical distance from others when you do need to leave the house for essential business and outdoor recreation is critical.

Ordinance Requiring All People Arriving in Sitka To Self-Quarantine - All people arriving in Sitka, whether resident, worker or visitor, are required to selfquarantine for 14 days and monitor for illness. Arriving residents or workers may only work from their place of self-quarantine, not their place of employment, unless they provide or support critical healthcare operations or infrastructure. Residents or workers in critical healthcare operations or infrastructure are required to receive approval by the Municipal Administrator, Essential services and critical workforce infrastructure is required...to Submit a plan or protocol to the State of Alaska, and also...to the City and Borough of Sitka by 3:00 p.m. April 24, 2020 at COVID-19.Action Plans@ cityofsitka.org.



Edgecumbe High School, 1293 Seward Ave. Appts. are required. For more information, or to schedule an appt, call 966-5204. For children due for immunization (but not needing WCC) the alternative site clinic will be utilized exclusively. Priority given to children ages 36 months and older and those who are behind on vaccinations. Temporary clinic hours are 8:30am to 4:30pm on Mondays & Fridays, and 1pm to 4:30pm on Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays. Drive-thru WCC will be scheduled for Tues., Weds., and Thur. from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. Only one patient (and parent

SEARHC Plan - All facilities have limited points of entry, with signage posted to direct patients and visitors to designated entrances. Visiting hours are limited to 8 a.m. - 8 p.m. until further notice, with all visitors at long-term care locations required to participate in a brief health screening. Supplies for the Alaska COVID-19 TEST are being distributed to all SEARHC clinical locations w/ results available within 48-72 hours. State tests will be supplemented with test kits from LabCorp. For testing, patients must be symptomatic, displaying a fever & cough, or shortness of breath. The CDC also recommends washing your hands, covering coughs & sneezes, cleaning / disinfecting surfaces &


