# Postage Stamps!

*Ideas for U.S. postage stamp subjects come from regular citizens, like you!*

**How are stamp designs selected?**

The Citizens' Stamp Advisory Committee evaluates stamp ideas from the public & meets 4x a year. U.S. stamps mostly feature American subjects to honor enduring contributions to American society, history, culture or environment.



A postage stamp is a small piece of paper issued by a country's postal service which pays the costs of delivering mail (postage!)



## Shape & Size

The usual shape of a postage stamp is a rectangle. Other shapes have been used in the past including triangles, rhombuses, octagons, circles, and even a banana shaped stamp issued by Tonga!



## Fast Facts!

Other countries use postage stamps too.

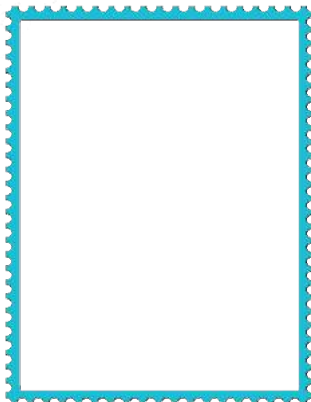
The U.S. Postal Service issues approx 35 stamps each year, and stamp programs are planned and developed 2-3 yrs in advance.

Stamps needed to be licked until 2002, when self-adhesive stamps became common.

Philately is the study of postage stamps and postal history.

100 years ago a stamp cost 2¢.
