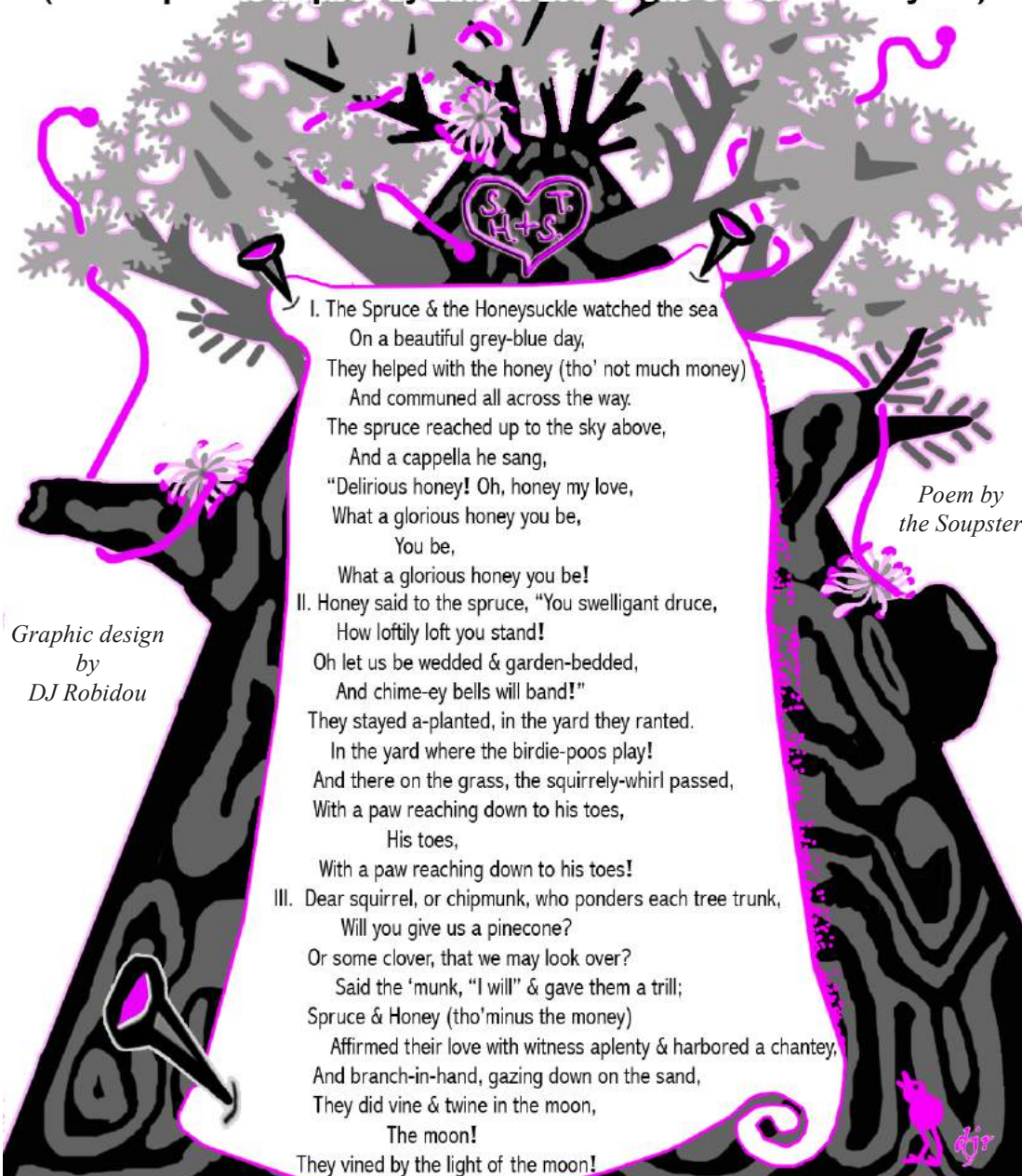

**Ferry System Plan for 2020-21** – DOT's proposed AMHS Ferry operating plan for Oct. 2020-April

2021 is now available for PUBLIC REVIEW. Communities & interested people can review and submit comments on the proposed operating plan through Friday, August 14th, via email at [dot.amhs.comments@alaska.gov](mailto:dot.amhs.comments@alaska.gov) and by fax at (907) 228-6873. There will not be a public teleconference during the comment period. Written comments accepted

through August 14, 2020. The draft operating plan is based on expected funding levels for fiscal year 2021. The plan is designed to meet community service needs while staying within available funding levels and maintaining regulatory and safety standards for the vessels. **Unified Command** - Sitka Case Count Update 8/10/20  
- Sitka Unified Command

received information on two positive test results for COVID-19 in Sitka - one on Friday, August 7 and one on Sunday, August 9. Sitka's positive test count is now at 29 resident cases, 13 non-resident cases, and 1 hospitalization. The State of Alaska is reporting 3,711 cumulative resident cases statewide. On Aug. 11 free airport tests for non-residents will cease. Free testing remains available at airports to Alaskan residents or a 14-day quarantine is still an option. Sitka Unified Command urges citizens to remain diligent and practice proper hygiene measures, such as washing your hands often. Stay home if you feel ill, wear a face covering when around others, and clean and disinfect objects and surfaces on a regular basis. COVID-19 symptoms are similar to the flu - fever,
