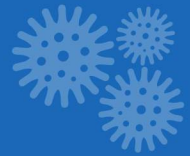

The Soupster hears about some post-Covid magic



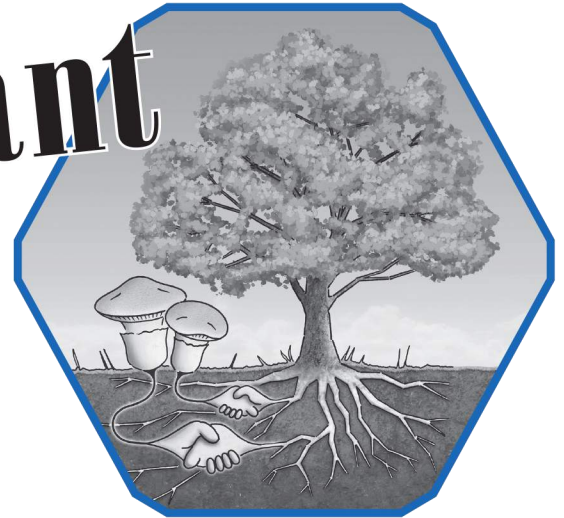

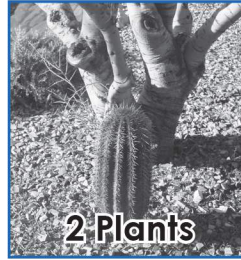
The most common plant symbiotic relationship is between more than 80% of land plants & fungi, called *mycorrhiza*.

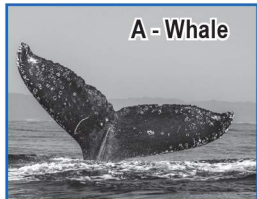
Symbiosis is any type of close, long-term, relationship between two organisms. They can be split into 3 types depending on the benefit or harm of the relationship to each organism.

1 Mutualistic refers to long-standing relationships where both organisms benefit without cost to either. *Examples:* pollinators & plants, Oxpeckers (bird) & grazing animals

2 Commensalistic occurs when one species benefits, while the other is unaffected. *Examples:* bird nest or spider web in a tree.

3 Parasitic: occurs when one organism, the parasite, lives off of another organism, the host, harming it and possibly causing death. *Examples:* strangler figs, lice & tapeworms.

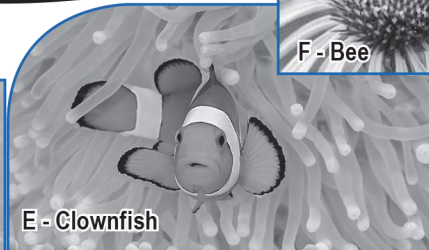
