



and drive thru options available. The School District is hosting a flu vaccination clinic for their staff and considering a clinic, with parent approval for students. The District had a staff member test positive for COVID-19 on Sept. 25. Staff was alerted on Sept. 29 regarding the uptick

in COVID-19 cases of the past 5-6 days and plans for moving forward with virtual instruction if necessary. Citizens should remain diligent and practice proper hygiene measures (washing hands often, avoiding close contact with others, keeping social circle small). 




