Conserve Water – CBS asks community members to conserve water to reduce possible water pressure decrease. The Water Division has been utilizing storage tank water since Nov. 10, due to high levels of turbidity in Blue Lake. It is important to conserve water while we wait for turbidity to drop. As Blue Lake water continues to

have high turbidity levels, this will be monitored to ensure that fecal coliform bacteria are w/in acceptable levels & to avoid the need for a citywide boiled water notice.
