






OUR TOWN

DID YOU KNOW

That 2021 is the 75th anniversary of the publication of John Hersey's book Hiroshima?

In August 1945, the U.S. military dropped nuclear weapons over the cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, leading to the surrender of Japanese forces and the end of World War II. This was the first time in history that nuclear weapons had been used in conflict. While Americans celebrated the end of the war, the U. S. government went to work minimizing the true human cost. Photos of mushroom clouds and headlines about the war's end became the American media narrative, while international journalists' reports of devastation were silenced or dismissed as Japanese propaganda.

In May of 1946, American journalist John Hersey traveled to Hiroshima and spent two weeks reporting on the human effects of the bombs from the perspective of six survivors. They spoke about the death they saw and the suffering of those who survived. When his book-length article was published in The New Yorker (Aug. 31, 1946) it was the first time the American public was exposed to a candid report about the bombs.

Hersey's Hiroshima has since been celebrated as a masterpiece of journalism, inspired generations of anti-war activists, and been hailed as one of the most important documents in the ongoing debate about nuclear war.

Aleutian Coral Gardens




Not all coral is tropical! In July 2002, tracts of coral gardens were discovered off the Aleutian Islands. 100 species of coral flourish at 300 to 5,000 feet below the surface.



Multiple species of deep-sea corals form an underwater garden **540** ft below the ocean's surface off the coast of the Aleutians. The term
coral "garden"
was coined by marine
ecologist Bob Stone,
because Aleutian
corals grow out of
a rock reef instead
of a coral reef.

Aleutian corals grow slowly due to the colder habitat.

Unlike shallow-water corals, deep-sea corals don't need sunlight!



Alaskan corals live for hundreds or even thousands of years, growing & reproducing very slowly.
