## Electrification is Key

*Say Some Climate Observers*

Citizens Climate Lobby wants to highlight for U.S. households the options available to save money while helping the climate. The August 2022 Inflation Reduction Act became the biggest climate bill ever passed in the U.S. Among other things, the IRA includes tax credits for electric vehicles, heat pumps, home efficiency upgrades and rooftop solar. Rewiring America, a pro-electrification non-profit, offers an online calculator to determine which incentives you may qualify for at [rewiringamerica.org/app/ira-calculator](http://rewiringamerica.org/app/ira-calculator).

*From ETIP - Available at Dec 13 Assembly*

In 2021, the National Renewable Energy Lab awarded CBS a grant for tech called "Energy Transition Initiative Partnership" (ETIP). Findings will be presented to the Assembly Tuesday, Dec 13. Sitka has at least 3 nearby sites with adequate wind to supplement hydropower. Solar power - cheapest potential energy source - might be useful at hydro low point in April - May.
